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PROTOCOL FOR USE OF FIRE HYDRANTS AND JETTING DURING CONSTRUCTION

- This permit is valid for jetting/village water usage for only one 10 consecutive working day period. Additional jetting on the same project after the initial period will require another new application but fee will be waived.
- Jetting may occur between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- An approved ramp, suitable for Vehicular Traffic (1" rise per foot) must be placed over the hose crossing any walkways.
- Ramp crossovers must be manned on-site by contractor's personnel at all times.
- All hoses, ramps, and materials must be removed and stored off-site daily—no materials will be left on streets or properties.
- Warning signage must be placed on both sides of ramped areas.
- Backflow device must be obtained from the DPW.
- Applications must be approved in writing by the Superintendent of Public Works or his designee prior to the issuance of permit and inception of work.
- Failure to abide by these rules will warrant triple fees for starting work without prior approval and fines.
