Project Description:

The applicant proposes to install and operate a temporary wellpoint dewatering system to facilitate the installation of new stormwater and sanitary sewer piping, associated catch basins and manholes, and a pump station. The dewatering system will consist of a maximum of 300 wellpoints installed to an approximate depth of 30 feet below grade and all dewatering discharge will pass through four (4) estimated 21,000-gallon frac tanks prior to discharging into existing outfalls, which ultimately lead to Great South Bay. The estimated average discharge will be 3.6 million gallons per day over 280 days and the maximum discharge shall not exceed 5,000 gallons per minute and 7.2 million gallons in a day. The project is located at Bay Walk, Village of Ocean Beach, Town of Islip, Suffolk County.
